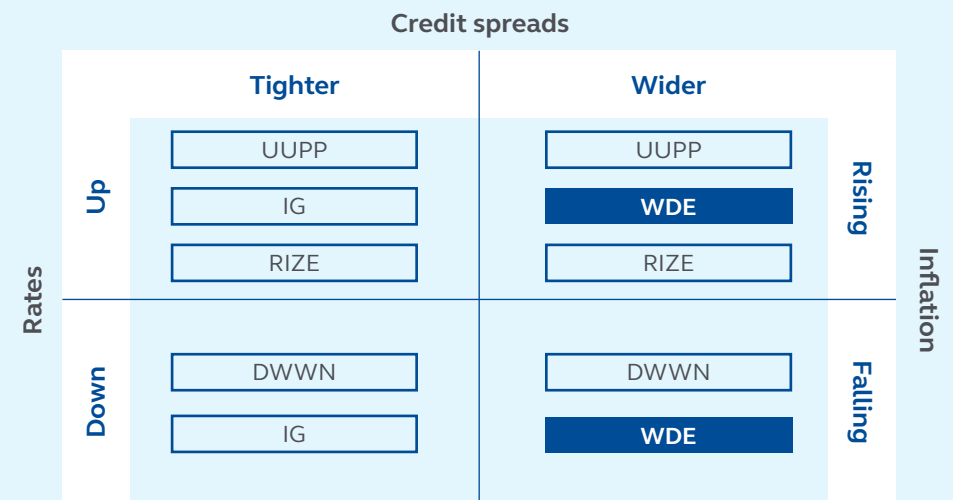

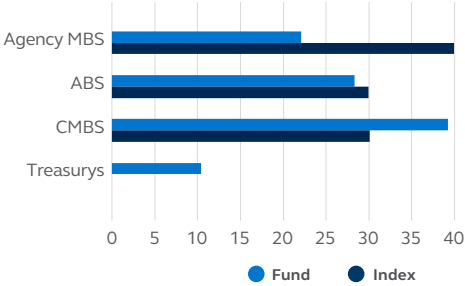

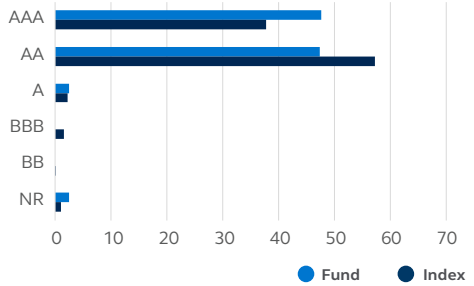

^{*9} 40% BBG U.S. MBS / 30% BBG U.S. ABS / 30% BBG U.S. CMBS is a custom index. The Bloomberg U.S. Mortgage Backed Securities (MBS) Index tracks fixed-rate agency mortgage backed pass-through securities guaranteed by Ginnie Mae (GNMA), Fannie Mae (FNMA), and Freddie Mac (FHLMC). The index is constructed by grouping individual TBA-deliverable MBS pools into aggregates or generics based on program, coupon and vintage.

The Bloomberg U.S. ABS Index is a broad market-value-weighted benchmark that tracks USD-denominated, investment-grade, fixed-rate asset-backed securities, including credit card, auto, equipment, and other eligible collateral types. Securities must meet minimum size requirements and have a remaining average life of at least one year to be included.

The Bloomberg U.S. CMBS Index measures the investment-grade market of U.S. Agency and U.S. Non-Agency conduit and fusion CMBS deals with a minimum current deal size of \$300m. The index includes both U.S. Aggregate eligible (ERISA eligible) and non-U.S. Aggregate eligible (non-ERISA eligible) securities.

The Bloomberg U.S. Securitized: MBS, ABS, and CMBS Index is a market-value-weighted benchmark tracking U.S. agency MBS, asset-backed securities, and commercial mortgage-backed securities. Eligible MBS must have a weighted average maturity of at least one year, while ABS and CMBS require a remaining average life of at least one year.
