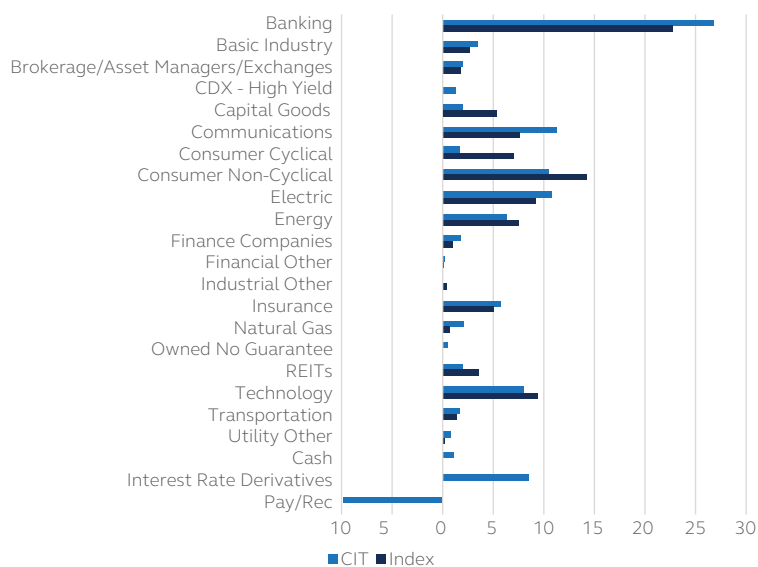

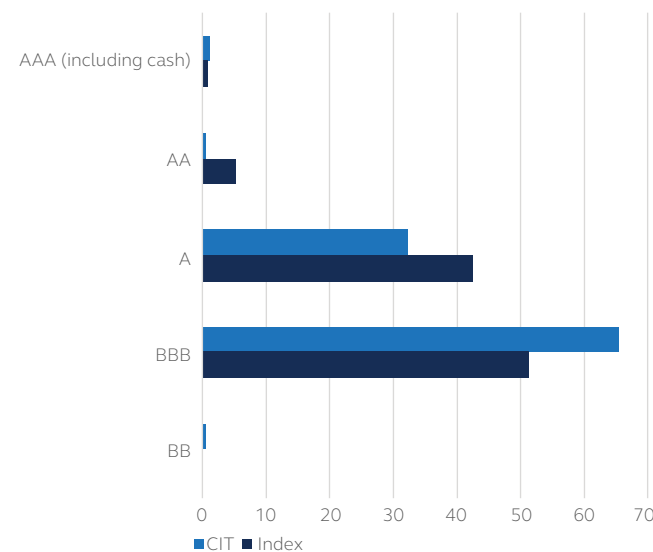

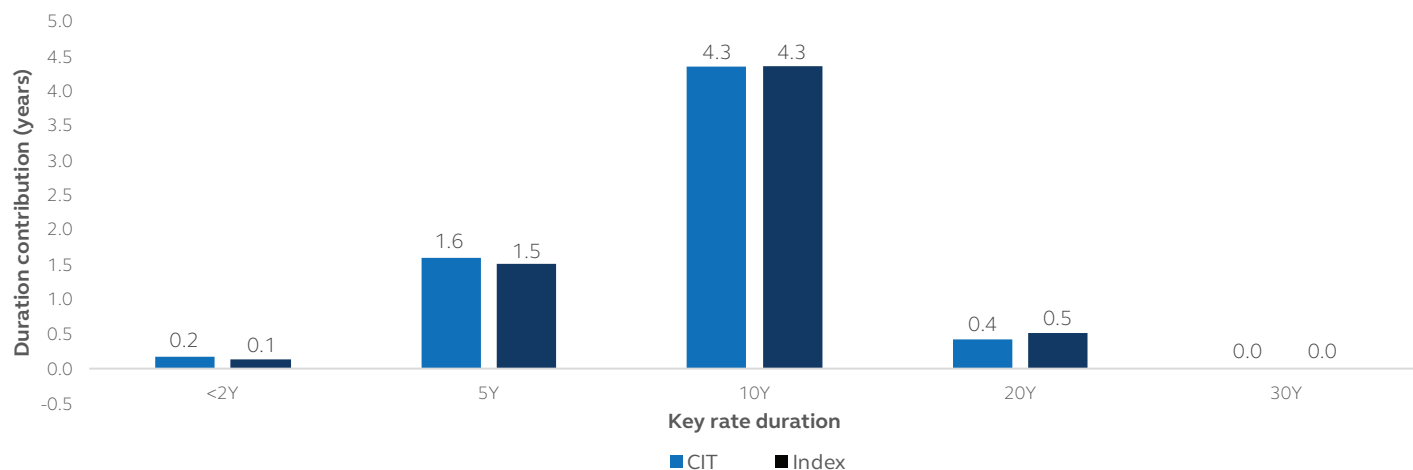
Sector allocation (%)
